FIFA Women's World Cup 2023™ teams: 32 nations will compete in the FIFA Women's World Cup[™] for the first time. The first tournament in China in 1991 featured 12 teams. It was expanded to include 16 countries at USA 1999 and 24 at Canada 2015.





Get Involved at Home

Welcome to Beyond the Pitch! This interactive website helps you and your child connect with the FIFA Women's World Cup 2023™ through online lessons and activities.

Beyond the Pitch is divided into four zones. Each zone includes an interactive lesson that can be accessed without signing in and can be played multiple times.







The Grandstand activity provides a great opportunity to explore the challenges and successes women have faced in becoming part of the football story. Historically, women have not always had opportunities to play football. Their inclusion in the modern game is a victory for everyone.

Here are some activities you can do at home with your child.

Women of Football

Research some key figures in the history of women's football and create a timeline of their life with key events listed in chronological order. Here are some examples to get you started: Marta (Brazil), Mia Hamm (USA), Abby Erceg (Aotearoa New Zealand), Sam Kerr (Australia).

Watch Women's Football
